

**MEN'S GOLF CLUB (MGC)**  
**STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES (SOP)**

Participation in any MGC event requires the following:

- Annual MGC Membership
- Annual AGA Membership
- Hole In One participation (paid annually)
- Daily Game Day entry fee

Dues and Daily Entry Fees are established by the MGC Board unless voted upon by the Membership.

- **MGC dues are specified on the Member Application and Dues Payment Procedure Documents**
- **Daily Game Day Entry Fee: \$8**

These dues do NOT include the required Arizona Golf Association (AGA) fees.

USGA Rules of Golf and MGC local rules govern golf competitions. The MGC will play USGA rules unless local rules are revised for a specific competition due to playing conditions. Additional local rules may be implemented if conditions warrant; example, winter rules or lift/clean/place.

Resident guests (Art II, Sect C) may participate in MGC game day events in a guest status three times per year. Thereafter, they must join the MGC as a regular dues paying member. Guests are not allowed to play in tournaments except member-guest tournaments.

A member's guest may play within a MGC game day but his scores will not be used in MGC Games, and are NOT eligible for individual or team prizes, guest will also not participate in the closest to the pin competition and therefore do NOT pay the event game fee. On Game Days where the number of players are limited (typically Monday & Friday), Guests will not be allowed if MGC Members are on the wait list. MGC members must have a current AGA handicap with at least 3 scores or a handicap may be established using the MGC Callaway system.

MGC Game Days: Game Day Chairmen will pay out prize money in accordance with an approved payout table provided to them. These tables will designate payouts based upon the number of players in each flight. Two man winning teams will split prize in half. Four man winning teams will split prize in quarters.

Ties for FIRST PLACE prize monies on MGC play days will be decided by scorecard playoff starting on Hole #1. In cases of ties for additional place winners, the prize monies will be divided equally among the tied parties. Tournament committees may alter this method.

To win "closest to the pin" (referred to as KP's) the player's ball MUST be on the putting green (not on the fringe).

Game Day Fees are required for each player. Closest to the Pin Prizes will be \$10 on Monday and Friday and \$15 on Wednesday, payable in cash. KP participation is not optional.

MGC Tournament Prize Money and Game Day Prize Money will be applied as pro shop credit to the Members Account.

The Hole In One (HIO) program is mandatory for all MGC members. MGC members must participate in the program. The cost, stated above is in addition to annual membership fees. The HIO fee is NOT prorated for partial year participation. The hole in one MUST be made at CCGC during an MGC event AND witnessed by an MGC member. Any HIO recipient will receive a check for \$500.

Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) may be changed by Executive Board vote.
