

MGC SUMMER SIZZLER TOURNAMENT RULES

GENERAL INFORMATION

- USGA Rules will be used except where local rules apply (see CC Score Card for local rules)
- There is no free relief for balls that come to rest against a turf edge.
- Complete relief from staked trees is only allowed if the stake or wires, not the tree, interfere with your stance or swing.
- All participants must be current MGC members and have AGA/GHIN Handicaps.
- All golfers will tee off from their respective tees as designated on the score cards.
- Handicaps for this competition are based on the GHIN handicap as of the latest posting prior to the start of the tournament. Handicaps from the 2 Methods of Play are calculated based on USGA recommendations for that method of play.
- Summer Sizzler Champions will be the combined individual score for all 3 rounds. There will be an "A" Flight and a "B" Flight with an equal number of payouts in each flight. The number of places paid will be based on the number of entrants. There will also be a Daily Team winner. In the case of a tie for First Place (either Daily or Overall), a score card playoff using the most current score card will be done starting with Hole #1.
- Closest to the Pin (KP's) will be paid for all par 3's each day. KP's will be Team KP's.

COMPETITION - Method of Play

- Each day play will consist of 6 holes of Scramble Play, 6 holes of Alternate Shot, and 6 holes of Two Person Best Ball Play.
- Two Person Best Ball – Both players will play their own ball. Best net score on the hole is the team score for that hole.
- Two Person Alternate Shot – Team mates must decide who will tee off on odd and who will tee off on even holes. Players will alternate shots from tee to hole out. Any penalty assessed or taken does not count as a shot taken by a player. Players may not substitute balls except as provided by USGA Rules for damaged or lost balls.
- Scramble – Both players will tee off on each hole and pick the best ball to hit their next shot from. Process continues until the ball is holed out. No minimum number of drives is required.

TOURNAMENT DISPUTES

- All tournament disputes must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Rules Committee immediately after the round for resolution. The Tournament Rules Committee will make their decision before the final standings for the day are announced. All determinations by the Tournament Rule Committee are final. For purposes of the tournament, the Tournament Rule Committee shall be the MGC President (or representative) and a representative from the Pro Shop.
